



34th Annual Brunswick Sound Spectacular Director Information

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- You will need 9 - 1GB SD Cards which are reusable and required for all of your adjudicated events next year.
- We will have small envelopes at check-in to make sure the correct card gets to the correct judge.
- The cards will be returned to you in these envelopes.
- You can purchase the cards at Wal-mart, Best Buy, Staples, Office Max, Radio Shack, etc.
- You will be able to load these cards onto your computer in order

- **Registration:** Registration will be located in the West House/9th Grade Entrance of our building. A member of your staff should check in at the registration table upon arrival. Restroom and changing facilities are available here as well.
- **Warm-up Areas:** There will be three warm-up areas (Warm-up A, B and Warm-up C. These are unlined areas, and they are paved with good lighting. You have been allotted 45 minutes to warm-up in the official warm-up area. You should allow approximately 10 minutes of travel time to make it to the gate. Your guides will take you to each of these areas.
- **Band Parking:** Bus parking will be in the Center Parking lot—behind our Recreation Center. Attendants will direct your buses to the appropriate location after you register. Students will be hand-stamped before they disembark from the buses.
- **Spectator Parking:** Spectator parking is located on the south and west sides of the stadium. **Spectator cars should enter on** Boyer Road. It is the second street past the Brunswick High School sign. Cars will proceed north on Boyer to Excellence Drive. Turn left onto Excellence Drive and follow until reaching the stadium Parking Lot. **Please communicate this with your parents to save unwanted frustration.**
- **Awards:** We will be awarding the first 3 places in every class as well as Best Percussion and Best Auxiliary in every class. Additionally, we will award overall Best Auxiliary, Best Percussion, Best Music, Best Marching and Maneuvering and Best General Effect. We will also award overall Runner-Up Grand Champion and Grand Champion trophies.

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- **Stadium Procedure and Flow:** Bands will enter and exit through a gate at the south end of the stadium. Each band will enter the stadium from the south end (the left side as you face the press box.) Your band will also exit the field to the left (as you face the press box). The gates should provide plenty of clearance for any props that you intend to use.
- **Band Seating:** Due to the expected size of the crowd, bands will be allowed seating on the visitors side of the stadium only.
We ask that you remind your band students to be attentive and respectful to performances by other bands and keep noise at acceptable levels.
- **Video recording:** There will be a designated video area provided at the top/center of the home stands. Only 1 member of your staff or parent volunteer will be allowed in the video area at any time.
- **Admission:** Ticket prices are: \$6 for adults and \$5 for Students/Senior Citizens.
- **Concessions:** A full line of food will be available at the stadium concessions located in the stadium concourse and at the south end of the stadium.
