Where: Buckeye High School Gym
How: Please have your parents/guardians drop you off at 5:30 P.M.
7th Grade you may put your instrument cases in the Auditorium.
High School and 8th Grade you may put your instrument together in the Band Room. Next you will join for a Combined Band set up for Grades 7-12 in the gymnasium. Concert is free and open to the public.

7th Grade Students are to take their instruments home on Friday and arrive on the scene with their instrument. All of the big equipment will be brought up to the high school.

Plan to arrive early at 5:20 P.M.. 7th Grade will meet in the Auditorium to assemble your instrument. Leave your cases in the Auditorium. We will warm up as a group in the Gymnasium @ 5:30 PM Sharp!. We will establish your seating arrangements in case of any problems.

Band members are to wear White/Black concert attire. White Shirt/Tie or Blouse with Black Slacks/Pants will be the dress code. Dark dress shoes preferably Black. No T-Shirts, Jeans or Tennis Shoes. Skirts must meet dress code and must be proper length. If you wish to wear seasonal colors and santa hats for this concert that will be acceptable. Lights are ok as long as they are battery operated. No decorative light types that are extension cords plugged into walls permitted to decorate instruments.
