Required Uniform Pieces

Welcome to the 2018-19 Buckeye Marching Band Season. We are so excited to get the year under way. One way to be successful is to look our best. On the back, you will find the **required items** and prices for our band members. Please note that many of these items can be reused for several years, provided they remain in good condition.

How do I order and pay for these uniform pieces?

1. When students come in to be fitted for their marching band uniform, they will order their other items in person with Mrs. Srail at that time. *Please discuss with your band member which items they need and what sizes they plan to order prior to their fitting.*
 - 12th grade – Thurs. July 5th at 6:30 pm
 - 11th grade – Thurs. July 5th at 7:15 pm
 - 10th grade – Thurs. July 5th at 8:00 pm
 - 9th grade – Mon. July 9th at 6:30 pm
 - 8th grade – Mon. July 9th at 7:15 pm
 - *If you have multiple students, bring both students at the oldest student's time slot.*
 - *Try to come during your slotted time, but if you cannot, come at the next available time slot.*
2. The **Boosters will email** parents an **invoice** of what your student ordered.
3. Parents will pay their invoice in either of the following ways:
 - On-line via PayPal: In your email invoice, there will be a link to click to pay your invoice.
 - By check: Print your invoice and send it in with a check made payable to Buckeye Band Boosters.
NOTE: Your invoice will automatically show an "online payment surcharge". The total of the surcharge is 2.9% of your order plus \$0.30. This is a fee charged to us by the host company, only if you are paying online. If you send in a check, you may deduct that fee from your total.
4. Orders and payments need to be made by **Wed. July 11th**. Due to timing, we must place the orders this week in order have needed items for pictures.
5. Once payments are made, items will be ordered. When ordered items come in, we will distribute them to the students. Student will only receive their items if their invoice is paid in full. Dates will be announced via email, Remind101, and on our Facebook page.

What are the required uniform pieces?

"B" Shirt - \$10.00 each

- a white T-shirt with the Buckeye Band "B" logo to be worn under uniforms for all football games. These are sometimes worn for Pep band, parades or other performances. It is a good idea to have 2, although only one is required.

"Tour" Shirt - \$10.00 each

- A T-shirt with the show logo on the front and listed dates of all performances for this season on the back. This will be required for all Competition Performances.
- Family members will be able to purchase Tour style clothing at this time, as well. Info will be posted when available.

Black Mesh Shorts – price TBS but estimated at about \$9/pair

- black shorts required under the uniform pants, also sometimes worn for parades or other performances.

Drill Masters Shoes- \$32.00

- black shoes worn by all band members for all performances. These come in Women's half sizes 5-12.5 and Men's half sizes 3-16.

White gloves - \$5/pair (2 pairs required!)

- NOT required for percussion
- Required white gloves with grip/wrist closure for all other band members for all performances.
- **Students will keep and launder their own gloves.** One pair reserved for games and one pair reserved for competitions. If a student needs to replace lost or forgotten gloves, they must pay for the replacement pair.
- It is a good idea to order an extra pair in case of damage, staining or loss. We will keep spare pairs at the school with uniforms so they are always available to the student. Additional pairs may be purchased through the Uniform Closet as the season continues.

Hat Bag – \$6.00

- Required for each student. This bag is what students will use to carry their personal items at games and for storing their hats while in the bleachers or on breaks. These may be saved and reused each season provided they are kept in good condition.

*In addition to the required items listed here, black socks (calf or knee high) are also required. You must purchase these on your own. No ankle or low cut socks. It is a good idea to start looking for "Under Armor" style clothing. Black long sleeved shirts and bottoms are very helpful during the colder end of the season.

*Marching Band Spirit wear will be sold separately from these items.
